- And everyone’s favorites: Sit & Stitch, Yoga, Gameday, Chess Club, and Friday walking groups, continue throughout February!

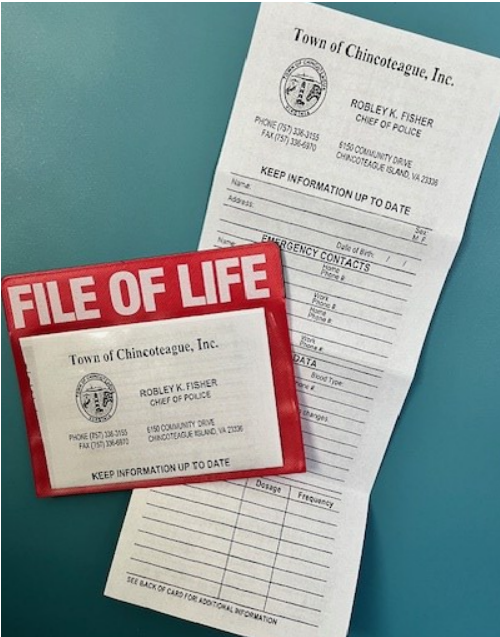
